
# **BUSINESS MINOR**

The Business Minor requires **5 CORE CLASSES** and **2 ELECTIVE CLASSES** = 28 units total



### **Business Minor Requirements**

- MAX 2 LOWER DIVISION CLASSES
- All classes must be taken as a LETTER GRADE with a grade of C- or better
- Students can overlap 8 upper division units between their major and minor
- -Only two transfer courses allowed toward minor requirements
- MGT 112 Global Business Strategy must be taken at UCSD.

## **Business Minor Requirements**

The Rady School of Management's Business Minor is the #1 declared minor at UCSD. The Business Minor will provide students with a broad understanding business theory, practices and applications within the fields of marketing, accounting, finance, operations and ethics. This minor is beneficial to students of all majors who envision careers that require a foundational knowledge of business principles.

### **Core Requirements** - Students must take five required core courses

- MGT 16: Personal Ethics at Work <u>OR</u> MGT 166: Business Ethics and Corporate Responsibility
- MGT 45: Principles of Accounting
  - Students may fulfill this requirement with the completion of both ECON4/MGT4 AND MGT5
- MGT 103: Product Marketing and Management
- MGT 181: Enterprise Finance
  - This class has two prerequisite courses: MGT3 or Math10A or Math 20A AND MGT45 or both MGT4/ECON4 and MGT5
- MGT 112: Global Business Strategy
  - o Prerequisites: MGT103 AND MGT181

**Electives** - Students must take two courses or eight units of electives

#### ONLY TWO LOWER DIVISION CLASSES ALLOWED FOR THE MINOR. Electives courses must be upper-division if students take both MGT 16 & 45.

Mini-Concentrations: While not a formal requirement, students can choose to take electives in the same category to have a "mini-concentration".

- Finance: MGT 12, MGT 183, MGT 184, MGT 185, MATH 193A, MATH 193B, MATH 194
- Marketing: MGT 105, MGT 106, MGT 107, MGT 109, COMM 1061, COMM 109D
- Organizational Behavior: MGT 18, MGT 117, MGT 162, MGT 164, COMM 106F, COMM 110G, SOCI 121, SOCI 132, SOCI 140F, SOCI 148E, PSYC 178
- Operations: MGT153, MGT 171, MGT 172, MGT 175, MGT 176, MGT 177, COMM 162
- Entrepreneurship: MGT 121A, MGT 121B, MGT 129, ENG 100B, ENG 100L, ENG 100D
